
How do I make a remote switch cable, is it ok to just connect pin 2 and pin 4 to push button switch? What is pin 3 going to do?

3.1.15 Remote switch Connector Remote switch is ideal for a remote botton which can act as an ATX power on/off botton.

2	Switch Signal	Low Active. Act as PC's ATX switch when external switch installed (Pin 3 Active) **Internal pull up resister did not connect to any power source

You need to connect pin2 (Switch Signal) and pin4 (GND) to a push button switch, besides you also needs to short pin3 (Ext. SW Sensor) and pin4 (GND), otherwise the switch will not work.
